



AMATEUR STUDENT INSTRUCTOR (ASI) ASSESSMENT CRITERIA

Practical demonstration

1. Candidate required to perform all ten dances of the ASI figures as Leader and Follower within a routine, with correct timing, footwork and alignments
2. Demonstrate how they would teach a class. Dance or dances will be of the Assessor's choice.

Theory

1. Basic knowledge and description of character/history of the dances
2. Technical knowledge of the ASI specified figures:
 - a. Amounts of turn
 - b. Footwork
 - c. Current BDC tempo and time signatures
 - d. Alignments
 - e. Holds
 - f. Construction of choreography (entries and exits)
3. Knowledge of Health & Safety, Risk Assessment and Safeguarding inline with current guidelines

Commencement of study date to be registered with Head Office by mentor. All paperwork, i.e. DBS and First Aid to be submitted to Head Office upon registering for the ASI assessment.

Approximate assessment time: 70 mins

Suggested guided learning hours: 15 hours
